The Lodge

Our Lodge was designed in the architectural style known as “Parkitecture” in honor of nearby Rocky Mountain National Park. The Lodge offers cozy single rooms and multi-room suites, a cafe, Heck’s - our casual restaurant, a theater, a business center, a six-sided three-story fireplace constructed from stones gathered from a rockslide near the Ranch, a library, and even a miniature bowling alley. It is stocked with rustic furniture, soft down pillows, warm bathrobes, and other amenities. Lodge rooms have televisions and DVD players. There are also televisions in the game room and Heck’s. Complimentary WiFi is available as well.

High Lonesome Lodge - Coming Winter 2013

Nestled on the hillside overlooking the Ranch, our new 50,000 square foot Lodge will include 31 guest rooms, four guest suites, wine grotto, and meeting and event space for groups of up to 360. The centerpiece of the Lodge is the High Lonesome Barn, a Civil War-era structure moved here piece by piece from Ohio, with a wall of windows and unparalleled views of the entire Ranch.



The Bunkhouse

Our charming former lodge? The original Elk Lodge at Devil’s Thumb Ranch was moved down the road a couple of miles and re-purposed as The Bunkhouse, a self-service lodging option. Designed for the budget-conscious traveler, The Bunkhouse includes nine rooms with private baths, four rooms with a shared bath, two common areas and a common full kitchen. The rooms are a bit smaller, but certainly cozy. Guests have access to the Ranch fitness center, pool area and game room; as well as a la carte prices for recreation, dining, spa and Ranch events. Bunkhouse guests must be over 16 years of age. At this time, the Bunkhouse is NOT dog-friendly. If you’re travelling with Rover, please request a dog-friendly cabin. A television with satellite service is offered in the common area, but there are not televisions in guest rooms at The Bunkhouse.

Cabins

Loft Cabins

Byers, Red Quill, Willow, Ouray, Settler and Wrangler Cabins have 1 queen bed, butler's kitchen and full bath.

2-Bedroom Cabins

Manitou, Traveler's Rest and Coyote Cabins feature 2 king beds, kitchenette with stove top and full bath.

Cabin Creek and Nordic Cabins feature 2 king beds, kitchenette with stove top, a full bath and 3/4 bath.

Taylor's and Coyote Cabin feature a full kitchen and full bath. Taylor's has 1 king bed and 1 queen bed, while Coyote has 2 king beds.

Ranch Creek and Trapper's Cabins feature 2 king beds, kitchenette with stove top and 2 full baths.

4-Bedroom Cabins

The Caroga features 2 king beds, 2 queen beds, a full kitchen, 2 fireplaces and 2 full baths.

The Blue Sky Lodge features 2 king beds, 2 queen beds, a full kitchen, 2 fireplaces, 2 full baths and 1 three-quarter bath.
